40 Days for Life Current Statistics:

- ✓ 24,801 Lives saved since 2007
- ✓ 154 Abortion centers closed

On Friday July 12th there will be a rosary on the front lawn at 12:10 in honor of the third apparition at Fatima.

The 40 Days for Life Fall Kickoff is September 10th 6:30pm at Saint Catherine of Siena Catholic Church, 1618 King Ben Road Kennesaw, GA 30144. The keynote speaker is Dr. John Bruchalski, author of the book 'Two Patients, My Conversion from Abortion to Life-Affirming Medicine'.

Despite relentless efforts by the far left to obstruct women from accessing life-saving support, pregnancy resource centers have persevered. Here are some remarkable insights into their impact:

- ✓ Over 2,750 pregnancy resource centers in the United States provided \$367,896,513 worth of goods and services to families in need—an increase of \$100 million since 2019.

- ✓ 16,050,312 clients were assisted in person or virtually.
- ✓ Over 60,000 paid and volunteer staff members work at pregnancy centers nationwide.
- ✓ 97.4% of pregnancy center clients reported a positive experience and satisfaction with their visit.

Curtis Bay Energy, which services much of the East Coast, converts aborted babies into electricity for use in households and businesses in the Baltimore, MD area.
