40 DAYS for LIFE

40 Days for Life Current Statistics:

- √ 25,795 Lives saved since 2007
- √ 182 Abortion centers closed
- √ 275 Abortion workers had a conversion and QUIT (that we know about) 1,000,000+ volunteers in 1,800 cities.
- ✓ Marietta 40 Days for Life / 365 have already saved 18 lives so far this year.

The facts are astounding: 80% of young women considering abortion will **CHOOSE LIFE** when they see their baby on an ultrasound and hear their baby's heartbeat. Without an ultrasound, one out of every three preborn babies will never see life.

PreBorn! is a dedicated non-profit, pro-life organization that supports life-affirming Pregnancy Clinics in their mission to reach women considering abortion, particularly in areas with high abortion rates. This is achieved by offering women free ultrasounds and support, as well as providing Pregnancy Clinics with vital grants for state-of-theart ultrasound machines, training, and additional resources. All services provided to expectant

mothers within the PreBorn! Pregnancy Network are offered at no cost, emphasizing their commitment to life. PreBorn! Claims to have saved over 337,000 babies lives and have seen over 80,000 women turn to Christ.

This is the reason 40 Days for Life sidewalk advocates stand and pray outside of Planned Parenthood, to get the women who are in crisis pregnancy and feel that their only option is an abortion, to get these women to talk with them. These women are explained that there are alternatives and help available. They are directed to go to the closest Pregnancy Resource Center (PRC) and get a FREE ultrasound and medical advice. All services with a PRC are free, so they have nothing to loose. In my discussion with the closest PRC, they report that 93% of pregnant women that visit them and have an ultrasound choose life. You see, Planned Parenthood does not show the women that are pregnant and considering an abortion their ultrasound. They fear that the women will not go through with the abortion.

Imagine you're a healthy, growing baby in the middle of your sixth month in the womb. Your mother is your whole world. You feel her heartbeat. Her joy. Her anxiety. Her fear. and then, one day, something changes. You feel your mother's body begin to cramp; hard; over and over. The tight squeeze of labor contractions, but it's not time yet, you're only 23 weeks old! Then comes the blinding light, the rush of cold air, and the gloved hands that drop you into a cold metal pan, not the warm waiting arms of your mother. You try to breathe, you try to cry, and your tiny lungs struggle to inflate. In hospital NICU, doctors would be racing to save you because babies born at 23 weeks have nearly a 60% chance of survival with proper care. But you're not being taken to the NICU. You're being taken to a laboratory, because this is not a delivery room, it is a Planned Parenthood abortion clinic. instead of treating you like a human being, they're treating you like property, a piece of meat. You were born whole. But instead of life-saving care, you were left to die in a "research" queue in the back of the clinic, and then you were dissected for your heart, your liver and your brain. Your body was sold not to strangers on the black market, but to taxpayer-funded scientists at the University of California at San Diego.
